

Near Miss Report Example It is convenient to have a report form ready when an almost miss event occurs. This pain caused the employee to stumble and almost finished, but he was able to use the scaffolding railing as a support. This is best achieved by putting it into practice. For example, an employee uses a ladder to fix a leak on a roof. The example of hazard communication shows that something as simple as labeling can lead to life-threatening events. They can also be completed on a mobile device for reports on startup. Meanwhile, the example of scaffolding safety shows that nearby failures may be caused by unexpected hazards or factors, not even related to the work itself. If the employee who experienced the nearby fault chose not to report it, the ladder might not have been inspected and the problem with the step would not have been discovered and solved.
